In this vital role, you'll be instrumental in preparing and analyzing tissue samples, directly supporting accurate diagnoses and exceptional patient care. This position requires someone with a strong grasp of laboratory procedures and a passion for maintaining the highest standards in quality and safety.

Key Responsibilities:

- Accurately accession specimens, ensuring all requisitions are complete, correctly matched, and thoroughly entered into the Laboratory Information System (LIS).
- Operate the microwave tissue processor, selecting appropriate protocols based on tissue type and size, and monitoring reagents per established protocols and guidelines.
- Embed fixed tissue specimens with precision, verifying each cassette against gross descriptions and properly orienting tissue in the mold; trim blocks as needed without damaging samples.
- Use a microtome to cut high-quality tissue sections at proper thickness, ensuring slides are wrinkle-free, clean, and correctly labeled and matched to the block.
- Perform and monitor H&E staining, including reagent rotation and quality control using control slides.
- Execute special staining techniques per protocol, validating results with appropriate controls; assist in preparing slides for external immunohistochemistry procedures.

Qualifications:

- Associate degree (A.A.) or equivalent from a two-year college or technical school; or 6 months to 1 year of related experience/training; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Candidates with CLIA-required coursework (Anatomy & Biology I & II) and at least two years of experience may also be considered.
- Board certification is preferred but not required.
